The **Referrers course** will equip dentists with theoretical knowledge about CBCT scientific principles, radiation doses, optimisation methods, regulations, selection criteria and clinical justification, etc, which will help the dentists meet legal and ethical requirements.

The speakers are Consultant Dental Maxillofacial Radiologists who all work at major teaching hospitals and have extensive experience in CBCT.

The **Interpretation course** is designed with many practical hands-on exercises for participants to do, in order to become familiar with CBCT scans of the dento-alveolar regions, with orientation of anatomy, software manipulation to visualise the area of interest, radiological differential diagnosis and writing of interpretation reports. This training will give participants the skills and confidence to write CBCT reports for their own patients.
